Temporary enrolment procedure for new members during Corona Virus restrictions (effective from May 2020)

For many years It has been the practice for a new member to attend one of the club meetings. As there are no immediate club meetings planned, during this period of enforced social distancing, the committee have agreed to accept electronic applications as listed in clause 6 of the constitution.

Step 1: A request for membership, including personal details and types of motorcycles, is to be made by contacting the membership officer or one of the branch secretaries.

Step 2: The secretary/ membership officer will review the application and send an application form to the applicant. The form may be e-mailed or posted.

Step3: The applicant returns the completed form to the secretary/ membership officer along with the membership fee and joining fee. Monies may be sent by cheque or postal order to the secretary/ membership officer, or by electronic funds transfer to BSB: 062279 Account No: 10015486

Step4: Once an application is received and paid for, the membership officer will email the committee with the applicants details for approval.

Step5: If no negative replies are received within 48 hours then the new member's acceptance is advised to them and a membership card issued by the membership officer. The new member can then make arrangements with one of the machine examiners to have their bike inspected for registration.

Step6: If the membership application is rejected, the applicant will be advised of this decision and their monies refunded.

It is expected the new member attend and introduce themselves at a club meeting, once the government allows the resumption of club meetings.
